Content, Format and procedures for sending proposals

The competition consists of three stages: registration, then two selection processes which correspond to two separate reports.

Registration: between February 1st and March 15th 2014

The registration period opens on February the 1st, at 12:00 pm and it closes March the 15th at midnight. The registration form can be downloaded from the website or it is available on request to the organizers. The complete registration form must be returned before March the 15 at midnight in digital format at the following address: uptrouville@gmail.com (validation on the site page automatically sends an email to this address). A confirmation will be emailed after the electronic validation.

Entry for the first selection: before May 15th 2014

The urban planning concepts proposed have to explore the territory of Trouville and have to be link to its environment. the project's explanation and the graphic expression will allow to understand the answer to the key issues outlined in the specifications. This entire report should be sent in PDF for the digital version. These items should be reported following very specific formats:

- A copy of the completed registration file between February 1st and March 15th, signed by all the team members,
- A statement of intent containing five pages, A4 : a cover page with the title of the proposal and the names of the team members, and four pages of argument.

It will endeavor to show how the program issues have been approached, describe the urban stakes, detail the developments and highlight the social and economic effects expected,

- A Financial estimation showing the cost of the various joints of the project, taking into account the potential economic benefits.

Teams will express their estimation on the most appropriate way.

- Five sheets A3 size, landscape or portrait format, CMYK:

- . A board overview with highlights of the proposed project.
- . An urban site analysis including sketches, drawings, plans, sections ... the scale will seem most relevant.
- . A script concept with diagrams, drawings or illustrations.
- . A comprehensive development plan at the most appropriate level.
This plan must show the project at the end of the proposed development.
- . Illustration, architectural, urban and landscape expressions (perspective views, plans and sections ...) of one or more key locations.

The orientation must be specified on all plans. The scale of all graphic materials must be specified.



The file of the first full report must be returned before May the 15th, 2014 at midnight in two formats:
digital PDF format on the platform of deposition site « équipes candidates » (« candidates teams ») and a paper format at the following address:

The selection committee will review the proposals and will select between 12 and 15 candidates, based on the quality of applications and on the criteria detailed in the specifications.

The nominees will be notified by email on June the 1st, 2014. To continue to participate in the competition, they will produce a second report for August the 31th 2014. The nominees propositions will be reviewed by the three juries.

Final entry : before August the 31th 2014

- A A0 board in full color on white paper with 190g white matte paper. This board will present a general overview and highlights of the response to the stakes.

The applicant team can use either portrait or landscape format. The print quality is fundamental because these boards will be presented to the public during the exposition.

- A seven minutes video in .wma format. This video will present the whole project in an original form and will allow the public and juries to capture the essence of the project. In addition to technical elements, urbanistic and architectural elements of the proposal, it will include a presentation of the team. This valuation will allow to see how the flow and circulation will be organized. A part of the film will focus on the cost estimate and another will focus on the expected benefits. To translate the project into images, all means can be used (filmed models, animations ...).

These videos will be viewed by the jury behind closed doors, and by the public during the exposition. In addition to these materials, applicants will add a resume for each team member, along with a copy of diplomas or proof of registration in a higher education institution for students.
